2 Manage Price Conditions

The management of price conditions has moved from the general app settings to the dashboard. The price condition options are accessible via *Manage Price Conditions*.

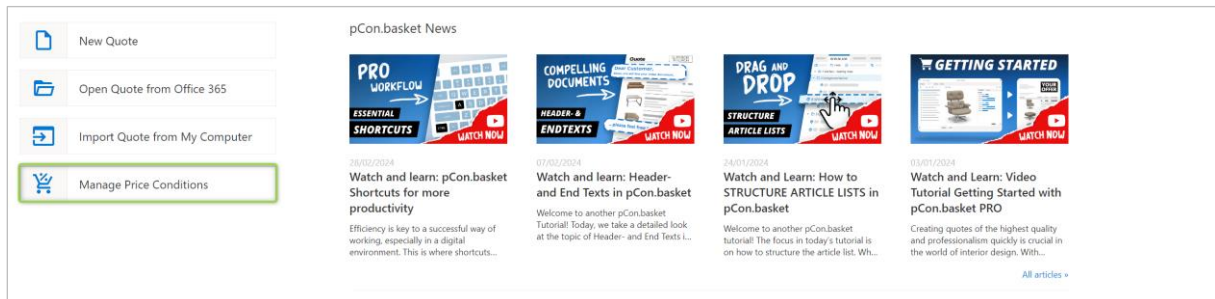


Figure 1 - Manage Price Conditions

2.1 Price Condition Profiles

The price condition solutions have been extended for users to maintain and work with different price condition profiles:

Price Condition Profiles can be created and maintained on 2 levels:

2.1.1 Manage Price Condition Profiles per pCon.login Organisation

User with administrator role in their pCon.login Manage organisation can predefine and maintain price condition profiles for all members of the pCon.login organisation.

While creating a new price condition profile, administrators can decide if it is visible for the organisation or just for their own account.

2.1.2 Personal Price Condition Profiles

Independent from their user role on pCon.login, every user of pCon.basket can create their personal price condition profiles. Further, they can decide which profile could be the default for new projects.

2.2 Internal and External Price Conditions

The options for predefining conditions have also been extended. With the upcoming release it's possible to define 4 different price conditions per manufacturer and series:

Figure 5 - Add price condition

- a) Purchase Price – internal: Describes a condition for changing the manufacturer's list price
- b) Purchase Price – external: Describes a condition that your company receives from the manufacturer
- c) Sales Price – internal: Describes the internal sales price calculation, does not appear on the quote
- d) Sales Price – external: Describes a condition for changing the sales price for the end customer

NOTE: The current price conditions (old solution) will be migrated to the default price condition profile named *Default*.

2.3 Set Price Condition for Project

The Header Data section contains the new *Price Conditions* entry. This is where the price condition profile for the current project can be set or changed. In addition, the content of the selected price condition profile is shown.

3 Reporting

3.1 New Logo Option

We added a setting concerning the integration of the *Logo* onto the templates. With the new version, we provide a dropdown menu with the following choice list:

- None
- First Page
- All Pages

3.2 Option for Variant Prices

Use the new option *Variant prices* to define whether the variant prices are shown as part of the calculation on article level or not.

3.3 Footer

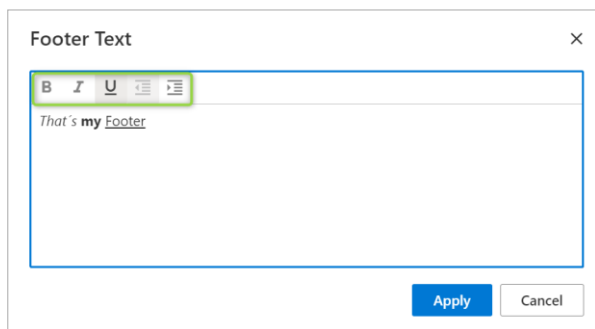


Figure 8 – Format footer text

With the new release it will be possible to format the text for the footer.

In addition, the option *Footer Text Align* provides the possibility to align the text for the footer to one of the following values:

- Right
- Left
- Center
- Justify

3.4 Country for Formatting

To grant you greater control over the formatting for currencies, numbers and dates for the reporting, we use the country-language combination as followed:


- Quote Language + Country of Customer Main Address (If specified)
- Fallback: local from Application Language

3.5 New Template: Product Comparison

With pCon.basket Online 2.12 we provide the additional report template *Product Comparison*.

The new template allows for comparison of up to 3 products per page. In addition, the template provides some options for managing the content of the report.

The OEX export dialog was enhanced with the following OEX conformable fields:

- Order Data:

 - o Additional agreement

- Delivery Options:
 - o Dispatch notes

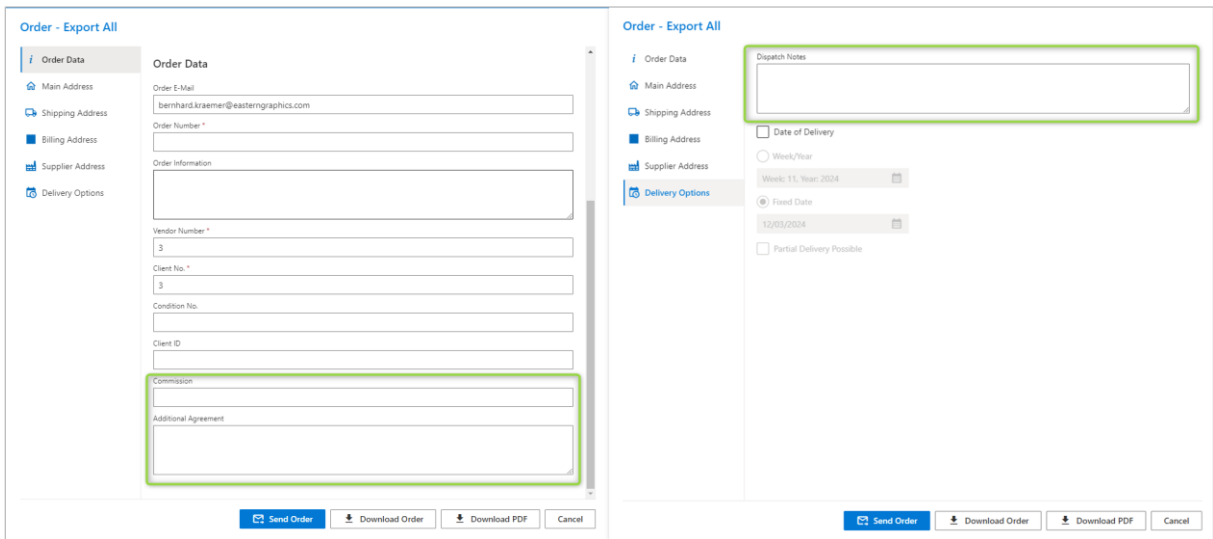


Figure 10 - Additional OEX fields

Furthermore, we provide the possibility to save the *Main Address* as default, so that users do not have to enter their *Main Address* for each OEX-Export again.

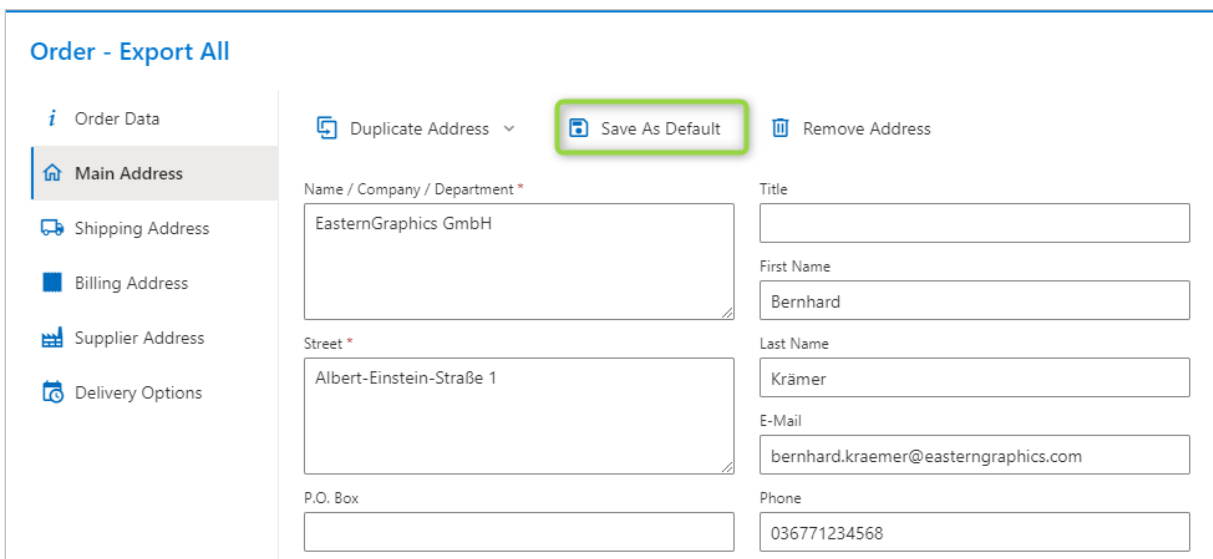


Figure 11 - OEX save default for main address

5 Additional Changes and Enhancements

5.1 CSV Exports

With Version 2.12 of pCon.basket Online, we have created two new options to export your article lists. The CSV exports provide additional ways to transfer the project to third party systems.

5.1.1 Export as CSV Archive

The export as a CSV archive consists of a ZIP archive containing the following files:

- Article_List.csv
- Header_Calculation.csv
- Header_Data.csv

The files contain the same structure and content as the similar worksheets in the Excel export.


5.1.2 Export Article List as CSV

This variant of the CSV export generates a single article list file which uses the same structure and content as the article list worksheet in the Excel export.

5.2 Contact/Address search extended

With the new release, the search for a contact via Office365 was extended so that it can be used for every address type. The *Search Address* button is provided in each address type section.

5.3 High-resolution Material Preview Images

The representation of high-resolution material preview images was adjusted so that the behavior in the underlying dialog works as follows:

- The images are always represented in the full size
- When clicking the image, the zoom will switch between 100% and 200%
- The magnifying glass was disabled, the zoom option is supported by the mouse wheel or pinch to zoom on touch devices
