# 1 Editable exchange rates

With version 3.14 we will support editable exchange rates. Like in the past, exchange rates will be retrieved from EAIWS when starting a new project. The exchange rates of the EAIWS are updated on a daily basis.

You will find the used exchange rates in your project settings.

It is also possible to save rates as default for new projects.

For all projects, the standard price date will be set to 'Today's date' whenever you open a project and you have not manually changed the standard price date in the list settings.

# 3.2 Display in article list

You will find the price date in the header calculation. The price date is only displayed here if all articles have the same price date. If the price dates for your articles differ, a hint will be displayed here accordingly.

# 4 Update of articles

It is now possible to select a price date on update of the whole article list.

All dialogs are structured the same way but differ in updating one article or all articles.

The dialog provides two options:

- 'Keep dates saved with articles': May result in different price dates when used to update all articles at once.
- Date: By default, today's date is pre-filled in the date field. You can change this to any desired date.

# 7 Augmented reality

With the new native container, we had to make some changes to the Augmented Reality of Android. We now use the native 3D presentation of Google. Therefore, we had to remove the configuration in Augmented Reality.

**Note:** Freezing of AR scene is only supported on apple devices.

## 8 Switch from Xamarin to ReactNative

The native container of the web view has been replaced due to end of life of our old solution. In this process, we had to reimplement a lot of functionalities (sharing, project management, Augmented Reality, login, etc.)
